Program Summary & Requirements

Through recent legislation, the State of Texas has allocated funding for schools to supplement the regular education program with compensatory, intensive, and/or accelerated instruction for students who are at risk in order to improve outcomes for these students and reduce disparity in performance between them and other students.

To plan for and implement this State Compensatory Education Program (SCE), TEC, §29.081 requires each local education agency to develop and maintain a district improvement plan and a campus improvement plan for each campus. For open-enrollment charter schools, these plans are called charter school instructional plans.

Pursuant to TEC, § 11.251 (a), school boards must ensure their schools develop, review, and revise these plans at least annually and boards must annually approve the district-wide and campus-specific performance objectives. Following development of these plans and objectives, schools determine how to use the funds on allowable expenses to support implementation of the plans.

The BASIS Texas SCE program includes instructional training in best practices for supporting students who are at risk, academic support services, and student/parent hours.

BASIS Texas District Profile

BASIS Texas is an open-enrollment, tuition-free public charter school serving grades K-12. BASIS Texas first opened its doors in 2013 and today serves a diverse population of students in both San Antonio and Austin. Our primary academic focus is to provide equal access to an internationally competitive college-preparatory education with above-grade level content covered as early as Kindergarten.

Data sourced from 2021-2022 Texas Academic Performance Report provides the following demographic profile:

The student population is 5.1% African American, 26.3% White, 44.5% Asian, 26.1% Hispanic, 51% male and 49% female with an economically disadvantaged status of 8.1%.

The overall mobility rate for the district is 8.6% with higher mobility in primary and middle school grades and a dropout rate of 0.7% in Grades 7-8, and 0% in Grades 9-12. The average daily student attendance rate for 2019-2020 school year was 98.1%.

Emergent Bilingual and English Language students make up 13.4% of the student population. Exceptional students with 504 plans represent 4.8% of the population, while students who receive special education services represent 2.8% of the population.
